For students who are academically strong and have a business-related career route in mind, these T Levels will give them a platform to engage with local employers and put theory into practice.

We have already invested £2+ million in industry standard facilities including mock hospital wards (built to NHS specifications), a nursery, wet science lab and cyber lab.

Students on the new business T Levels will have access to a replica office environment to help bring together the skills learnt in the classroom and in the workplace.

"If you're considering doing a T Level it's definitely worth it. It gives you all of the skills and experience that employers actually look for, rather than just having a qualification.

The teachers are fantastic; they are very knowledgeable and have a great method of teaching. One of the live briefs we worked on was developing an app to help the T Level Health students in the training hospital input and maintain patient records electronically.

I like having the open classroom because it feels more like a workplace and it allows us to collaborate more freely than if we were in a normal classroom."
