When revising, we recommend working in 20 minute intervals, then taking a 5 minute break, then back for another 20 minutes, rinse and repeat!

A useful technique we recommend is 'blurting'- students watch a video, then write down as much as they can remember before using a revision guide or watching the video a second time to expand their notes.

Past papers are also a useful revision tool- many sample and past papers are available to download from the AQA website.
