• The Robinson Access Programme is a free programme of webinars for Year 11 and 12 students, designed to help students think about university as an option for the future. The programme will consist of online sessions held most weeks after school from January to March 2024. Some sessions will be applicable to both Year 11 and 12 students. These include sessions on Cambridge life and studies. There will also be sessions aimed at either Year 11 or Year 12, on choosing A Levels or thinking about the university application process. They particularly encourage applications from Year 11 or Year 12 students if you are curious to learn more about what life is life at a university such as Cambridge, and how to make strong applications. However, you are still welcome to apply even if you are unsure as to which universities you want to go to, or whether you will go at all.


